1. Who we are

We are Inovotek Solutions Ltd a global business and technology consultancy dedicated to the financial markets sector. We act as a **data controller** when processing personal information about candidates and clients

2. What personal data we collect

We may collect and process the following types of information:

- Candidates: Name, contact details, CVs, employment history, qualifications, references, interview notes, and (where relevant) right-to-work documentation, diversity data, or background checks.
- Clients: Business contact information, job role requirements, and correspondence.

We will only collect what is necessary for consultancy purposes.

3. How we use your personal data

We use personal data to:

- Match candidates with job opportunities.
- Share candidate CVs and profiles with prospective clients (with candidate knowledge).
- · Communicate with candidates and clients.
- Meet our legal and contractual obligations.

Our lawful bases for processing are:

- **Legitimate interest** matching candidates to roles, maintaining business relationships.
- **Consent** where required (e.g., sending job alerts or processing special category data).
- Contract fulfilling agreements with clients and consultants.



• **Legal obligation** – compliance with employment law, right-to-work checks, HMRC requirements.

4. Who we share your data with

We may share your data with:

- Clients for relevant consultancy opportunities.
- Third-party service providers (e.g., IT systems, cloud storage, payroll, background check services).
- Regulators or legal authorities where required by law.

We will not sell your personal data.

5. International transfers

If we transfer data outside the UK/EEA, we ensure appropriate safeguards are in place.

6. Data retention

We keep personal data only as long as necessary:

- Candidate records (CVs, applications, notes): As long as there are potential roles that meet your skill sets.
- Client contact details: As long as we have an active business relationship, or discussing potentially working together in the future.
- Legal/financial records: As required by law (typically 6 years).

You can request deletion of your data at any time.

7. Your rights under UK GDPR

You have the right to:

- Request access to your personal data.
- Correct inaccuracies.
- Request deletion ("right to be forgotten").
- Restrict or object to processing.
- Request transfer of your data (data portability).
- Withdraw consent at any time (if consent is the lawful basis).

8. Data security

We use appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect personal data, including:

- Secure storage and encryption.
- Access controls (only authorised staff can access candidate/client data).
- Staff training in GDPR and data protection.

If a data breach occurs that risks your rights and freedoms, we will notify the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) within 72 hours and inform affected individuals where required.
